Important Parade Information

To ensure that the parade runs as smoothly as possible, it is important that you follow the guidelines listed below.

1. The parade will start at 9:00 a.m. sharp from Mid Rivers Mall parking lot on Saturday, June 14, 2008. Due to the large number of entries, plan to arrive between 7:00 and 8:00 a.m.
2. Upon arrival, you must **check in** and receive a number that designates your place in line. This number must be displayed prominently on the front, left side of your entry.

Parade Restrictions

1. Anyone operating a motorized vehicle must be 18 years of age or older with a valid drivers license.
2. Know that the parade must keep a certain pace and all participants walking must be able to keep up.
3. No literature of political nature shall be dispersed before or during the course of the parade. If this rule is violated, you will be asked to leave the parade.
4. Floats over two feet high must have a restraint around the perimeter.
5. No candy or other types of items shall be thrown from your entry (this is a potential safety hazard). If any items are thrown, you will be asked to leave the parade. We will allow candy to be **HANDED** to parade watchers.

End Of The Parade

To eliminate traffic tie-ups, we ask that you disperse in the following manner:

Buses will be waiting at Brown Road Park for anyone walking or marching and will return to Mid Rivers Mall

Lone Wolf Park

Horse Entries

Brown Road Park

Mini cars, mini jeeps, etc.

Hwy 79 to Hwy 70

Floats, cars, engines and trucks

Please have someone in these locations for the loading of horses and cars.

Please have someone present at the awards ceremony to pick up any award your entry may have won. The judge's stand will be in front of the American Legion Hall.
